

# Form I-821D

## CONSIDERATION OF DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS

### WHEN TO USE THIS FORM?

To request that USCIS consider deferring action, on a case-by-case basis, based on guidelines described in the [Secretary of Homeland Security's memorandum issued June 15, 2012](#). Deferred action is a discretionary determination to defer removal action of an individual as an act of prosecutorial discretion. Individuals who receive deferred action will not be placed into removal proceedings or removed from the United States for a specified period of time. Individuals filing Form I-821D **must also file Form I-765, [Application for Employment Authorization](#), and Form I-765WS, Form I-765 Worksheet.**

### FILING FEE:

The total fee for forms I-821D, I-765 and the I-765WS is **\$465**. (This fee includes a \$380 form fee for the I-765 and an \$85 biometric services fee.)

- The check or money order must be drawn on a bank or other financial institution located in the United States and must be payable in U.S. currency; and
- Make the check or money order payable to **U.S. Department of Homeland Security**, unless:
  - If you live in Guam, make it payable to **Treasurer, Guam**
  - If you live in the U.S. Virgin Islands, make it payable to **Commissioner of Finance of the Virgin Islands**

### ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Form I-821D, I-765 and I-765 Worksheet must be filed as a packet. USCIS will not consider deferring action in your case unless Form I-821D is accompanied by Form I-765 with fees, and form I-765WS.
- There is NO Fee Waiver.
- Type or print legibly in black ink
- If you need additional space to complete any item on Form I-821D, proceed to **Part 7 – Additional Information, of the form**.
- Answer all questions fully and accurately. If an item is not applicable or the answer is “none,” leave the space blank.
- You do not need to submit original documents unless USCIS requests them
- Evidence and supporting documents that you file with your application should show that you meet all of the requirements.

## **I-765 Filed with I-821D**

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION**

- Your application with the filing fee (See Page 1)
- A copy of Form I-94, Arrival Departure Record (front and back), if available.
- A copy of your last EAD (front and back). If no prior EAD has been issued, you must submit a copy of a Federal Government-issued identity document, such as a passport showing your picture, name, and date of birth; a birth certificate with photo ID; a visa issued by a foreign consulate; or a national ID document with photo and/or fingerprint. The identity document photocopy must clearly show the facial features of the applicant and the biographical information
- Two identical color photographs of yourself within 30 days of filing your application. The photos must have a white to off-white background, be printed on thin paper with a glossy finish, and be unmounted and unretouched. Using pencil or felt pen, lightly print your name and Alien Receipt Number on the back of the photo.
- Form I-765WS

**Remember to submit Forms I-821D, I-765, I-765WS and fees together**
